

Requirements for Contestants

Each applicant must furnish a minimum of his/her own tool pouch and hand tools:

2 pair slip joint pliers	12" hacksaw frame and blade	Torpedo Level	1—3" - 6" screwdriver
1- #2 Phillips screwdriver	Ruler or tape measure	Wire stripper	Pencil
Work Gloves	Pocket knife	Cutting pliers (lineman)	½ & ¾ in EMT Benders
Fish tape (Nylon or Metal)	Hardhat—worn at all times	Awl	Voltage tester

Goggles or Safety Glasses (with full side shields)			

Battery powered drills or screwdrivers will be permitted.
(NO ELECTRIC DRILLS)

Must wear ANSI safety approved footwear. Steel-toed footwear is not required.

First place winner ineligible to compete in future contests.

Contest limited to 40 qualified contestants.

Contestants must be registered by 7:30 am to compete.

Contestants will be judged on a hands-on project and a written examination.

All judging is final.

Only material furnished by apprenticeship committee allowed to be used

JUDGING CATEGORIES

You will be judged on the following items

- 1. Neat workman like manner, Accuracy of layout and installation, and Safety**
- 2. Productivity, Adherence to the National Electrical Code, and Operation of energized system**
- 3. Hands on project is 75% of the final score**
- 4. Written examination is 25% of the final score**
